#### Achievements -2020-2021 - At a Glance


National Council for Cooperative Training (NCCT) is a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 promoted by Ministry of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare, Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmer's Welfare, Government of India. NCCT is responsible for organizing, directing, monitoring and evaluating the arrangements for cooperative training for the personnel working in the cooperative sector in the country as well as other stakeholders of Cooperative Sector. The main objective of the Council is to organize need-based training programmes and facilitate the process of human resource development for cooperatives of the country. It also envisages researching critical areas of cooperative movement. These activities of National Council for Cooperative Training are conducted through 20 Institutes at National Level, Regional Level and State Level located all over the country. NCCT units have also exhibited their role on doing consultancy services and conducting research projects in potential areas of cooperative sector. All the RICMs and ICMs are accredited with C-PEC, BIRD, Lucknow.


During the year 2020-2021, NCCT's Training Units have organized 1100 Training programmes with 40288 participants against the target of 1740 programmes with 43500 participants. There has been a marginal shortfall on achieving target during the year, 2020-2021 due to prevailing Covid-19 Pandemic. The achievements were adversely affected due to the Covid pandemic crisis and as a result funding agencies did not turn up to sponsor Training programs appropriately and also beneficiaries and other stake holders were not inclined to undergo Training programmes. Besides, majority of the Training Institutions were taken over by the State Govt. converting the premises into Quarantine Centres which also affected the target.

### ACHIEVEMENTS ON ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

Apart from organizing routine training programmes, the training units of NCCT have also conducted professional courses like PGDM (Agri-Business), MBA, PGDCA, BBA, and Diploma in Rural Management orienting the participants with the upgraded knowledge, skills and attitude, behavioral change as a pre requisite for makeover towards attaining professionalism on managing cooperatives, corporate establishments and other entrepreneurial developments.

#### Faculty Development Programmes

The Council regularly nominates its faculty members to the IIM, Ahmadabad to upgrade their academic and research expertise. So far 37 faculty members have completed Faculty Development Programme (FDP) at IIM, Ahmadabad under the sponsorship of NCDC. A total of 65 faculty members successfully cleared the Certified Trainer programme for Financial Cooperatives (CTFC) course offered by the Centre for Professional Excellence in Cooperatives (C-PEC), BIRD, Lucknow and have become certified trainers for credit cooperatives.

NCCT deputed 12 faculty members of RICMs/ICMs in the 54<sup>th</sup> Batch of Post Graduate Diploma in Cooperative Business Management (PGDCBM) organised by VAMNICOM, Pune from 2<sup>nd</sup> November, 2020 to 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2021.

#### **MAJOR EVENTS**

#### Governing Council Meeting of NCCT

The 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting of the Governing Council of the National Council for Cooperative

Training (NCCT) was held on 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2020 at 4.30 p.m. via Google Meet under the Chairmanship of Shri Parshottam Rupala, Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Agriculture & Farmers Welfare. Shri Mohan Kumar Mishra, Secretary, NCCT & Member Secretary of the Council extended warm welcome to members of the Governing Council and briefed about the action taken on the decision taken in the last GC Meeting and academic activities carried out by the units of NCCT during 2019-20. Thereafter the agenda items were taken up for consideration and decision.

CPWD with the help of its team of expert construction engineers has constructed this hostel within the stipulated time frame even when the world is struggling with COVID

# Video Conference on Funding of Projects on Post-Harvesting Infrastructure and Management

A video Conference via Google Meet was held on 1.6.2020 at 4.00 p.m. under the Chairmanship of Shri Vivek Aggarwal, IAS, Joint Secretary (Cooperation), Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare on Funding Projects on Post-harvesting Infrastructure and Management. The Joint Secretary mentioned that the Government of India has proposed to provide Financial assistance up to 1,00,000 crores for the next 4 years including the current financial year, to set up Post-harvest Management Infrastructure as well as Community Farming Asset so that there will be a long term benefit for farmers and sustained employment opportunities. He also highlighted the existence of clusters for citrus, grapes, fruits and inadequate facilities for warehousing, cold storage, sorting, grading and standardization, packing and waxing etc. On the above background, he has requested all Directors of the units to undertake a preliminary study, collate the ideas, and submit 10-15 projects which will be suitable in the respective areas. The Video Conferencing was attended by the Secretary, NCCT and Officers of NCCT Head Quarter and the Directors & Faculty Members of VAMNICOM/RICMs/ICMs.




