Prayagraj: National Cooperative Exports Limited (NCEL), set up by the Ministry of Cooperation, expected to export approximately Rs 400 crore worth of sugar, rice, and onion during April 2024. NCEL was set up under the Multi-State Cooperative Societies (MSCS) Act, 2002 in January 2023 to provide a complete ecosystem for the promotion of exports mainly of agri commodities for the benefit of farmers and achieve the goal of "Sahkarse-Samriddhi". Cooperative societies from primary to national level can become members of NCEL. Ashish Kumar Bhutani, Secretary, the Ministry of Cooperation, recently reviewed progress achieved by the NCEL. Among others, the meeting was attended by Pankaj Kumar Bansal, AS (MOC), NCEL Chairman.

एनसीईएल अप्रैल में 400 करोड़ रुपये की चीनी, चावल, प्याज का निर्यात करेगीः सहकारिता मंत्रालय

गोरखपुर। सहकारिता मंत्रालय द्वारा स्थापित नेशनल कोऑपरेटिव एक्सपोर्ट्स लिमिटेड (एनसीईएल) को अप्रैल 2024 के दौरान लगभग 400 करोड़ रुपये की चीनी, चावल और प्याज का निर्यात करने की उम्मीद है।

एनसीईएठ की स्थापना जनवरी 2023 में बहु-राज्य सहकारी सो सायटी (एमएससीएस) अधिनियम, 2002 के तहत किसानों के ठाभ के ठिए मुख्य रूप से कृषि वस्तुओं के निर्यात को बढ़ावा देने और 'सहकार-से-समृद्धि' के ठक्ष्य को प्राप्त करने के ठिए एक पूर्ण पारिस्थितिकी तंत्र प्रदान करने के ठिए की गई थी।'। प्राथमिक से ठेकर राष्ट्रीय स्तर तक की सहकारी समितियाँ इसकी सदस्य बन सकती हैं। सहकारिता मंत्रालय के सचिव सचिव डॉ. आशीष कुमार भूटानी ने हाल ही राष्ट्रीय सहकारी निर्यात लिमिटेड (एनसीईएल) द्वारा की गई प्रगति की समीक्षा की। अन्य लोगों के अलावा, बैठक में अतिरिक्त सचिव पंकज बंसल, और एनसीईएल चेयरमैन ने बैठक में भाग लिया।

बैठक के दौरान एनसीईएल एमडी ने प्रस्तुति दी और बताया कि वित्त वर्ष 2023-24 के दौरान एनसीईएल ने विभिन्न देशों को लगभग ?1100 करोड़ के चावल, प्याज और गेहूं का निर्यात किया, सहकारिता मंत्रालय ने 'एक्स' पर एक सोशल मीडिया पोस्ट में कहा।

एक अन्य पोस्ट में कहा गया, अप्रैल 2024 (वित्त वर्ष 2024-25) के दौरान विभिन्न देशों में चीनी, चावल और प्याज का अपेक्षित निर्यात लगभग 400 करोड रुपये होगा।


एनसीईएल का गठन निर्यात को बढ़ावा देने के लिए एक छत्र संगठन के रूप में कार्य करके सहकारी क्षेत्र से निर्यात को बढ़ावा देने के लिए किया गया है। इससे वैश्विक बाजारों में भारतीय सहकारी समितियों को बेहतर बुनियादी ढांचे, विशेषज्ञता और बाजार संपर्क तक पहुंच प्रदान करके उनकी निर्यात क्षमता को बढ़ाने में मदद मिलेगी।

मार्च में, केंद्रीय गृह मंत्री और सहकारिता मंत्री अमित शाह ने तीन बहु-राज्य सहकारी समितियों -राष्ट्रीय सहकारी निर्यात लिमिटेड (एनसीईएल), भारतीय बीज सहकारी समिति लिमिटेड (बीबीएसएसएल) और राष्ट्रीय सहकारी ऑर्गेनिक्स लिमिटेड (एनसीऔएल) के नए कार्यालय भवन का नई दिल्ली में उद्घाटन किया था।.

मंत्रालय ने संसद को सूचित किया था कि एनसीईएल 'संपूर्ण सरकारी दृष्टिकोण' के माध्यम से केंद्रित तरीके से भारत सरकार के विभिन्न मंत्रालयों की विभिन्न निर्यात-संबंधित योजनाओं और नीतियों का लाभ प्राप्त करने में सहकारी समितियों की भी मदद करेगा।

चार प्रमुख सहकारी समितियाँ-गुजरात सहकारी दुग्थ विपणन महासंघ (जीसीएमएमएफ - अमूठ), भारतीय किसान उर्वरक सहकारी (इफको), कृषक भारती सहकारी (कृभको) और भारतीय राष्ट्रीय कृषि सहकारी विपणन महासंघ (नेफेंड) और राष्ट्रीय सहकारी विकास निगम (एनसीडीसी)) ने संयुक्त रूप से एनसीईएठ को बढ़ावा दिया है।
