Shri Mohan Kumar Mishra, Secretary, NCCT & Member Secretary of the Council extended warm welcome to members of the Governing Council and briefed about the action taken on the decision taken in the last GC Meeting and academic activities carried out by the units of NCCT during 2019-20. Thereafter the agenda items were taken up for consideration and decision.

WEBINAR ON EMERGING CHALLENGES BEFORE COOPERATIVE EDUCATION AND TRAINING DURING AND POST COVID-19 ORGANISED BY NCCT ON 22nd MAY, 2020

A webinar was organized on "Emerging Challenges before Cooperative Education and Training during and Post COVID-19" by NCCT through Google Meet on 22nd May 2020. The webinar schedule and an online registration form along with a detailed agenda had been shared by NCCT well in advance,

through which more than 300 scholars registered and attended the webinar. The webinar started with a welcome note by Shri Mohan Kumar Mishra, Secretary NCCT. He extended a warm welcome to Shri Parshottam Rupala, Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Agriculture & Farmers Welfare distinguished panelists and participants. In his welcome note, he elucidated that the COVID-19 transformed the conventional training environment wholly and NCCT and its Training Units including other Cooperative Training Institutions (CTIs/JLTCs) are striving to adapt to this new environment and offer online programmes and online solutions across the country.

While inaugurating the webinar, Chief Guest Shri Parshottam Rupala, Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Agriculture & Farmers Welfare has started the proceedings as a panelist. He appreciated the efforts of NCCT in organizing the Webinar during the COVID 19 crisis. He highlighted the announcement of relief packages to various states affected by COVID-19 Pandemic; under the leadership of Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India. He said that NCCT is engaged in imparting training to the cooperative personnel throughout the country for the last six decades and can play a vital role by educating farmers through awareness programs in which key features of government policies clarified in regional and vernacular languages.

Shri. Satish Marathe, Director, RBI, Shri Petluri Srinivas, Chairman, WDRA, Dr. K.K.Tripathi IES, Director, VAMNICOM, Dr. Desai IAS RCS, Gujarat, Smt. Vijaya Laxmi Additional Registrar, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh, Dr. Harekrishna Mishra, Professor, IRMA were the panelists and addressed the key issues during the Webinar.

VIDEO CONFERENCE ON FUNDING PROJECTS ON POST-HARVESTING INFRASTRUCTURE AND MANAGEMENT

A video Conference via Google Meet was held on 1.6.2020 at 4.00 p.m. under the Chairmanship of Shri Vivek Aggarwal, IAS, Joint Secretary (Cooperation), Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare on Funding Projects on Post-harvesting Infrastructure and Management. The Joint Secretary mentioned that the Government of India has proposed to provide Financial assistance up to 1,00,000 crores for next 4 years including the current financial year, to set up Post-harvest Management Infrastructure as well as Community Farming Asset so that there will be long term benefit for farmers and sustained employment opportunities. He also highlighted the existence of clusters for citrus, grapes, fruits and inadequate

facilities for warehousing, cold storage, sorting, grading and standardization, packing and waxing etc. Due to which farmers are compelled to sell their produce at a reduced price. Also, he mentioned that ripening unit for banana plantation, sorting and packing of mangoes and apples will be required. Similarly, cereals produced by North-Eastern States, traditional coarse grains from tribal areas of M.P, Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka; require primary processing infrastructure to make the produce saleable at a better price for

farmers. He also said, there is a scope for post-production processing and value addition activities and there is no dearth for funding.

On the above background, he has requested all Directors of the units to undertake a preliminary study, collate the ideas and submit 10-15 projects which will be suitable in the respective areas.

The Institutes, providing viable projects might get permanently engaged with those projects which will give handholding and capacity building in the beginning and this will result in revenue generation for that Institute.

VIDEO CONFERENCE ON STRATEGIZE THE TRAINING & EDUCATION PROGRAMME DURING LOCKDOWN AND POST COVID PERIOD

Owing to the mounting challenges that are prevailing due to Covid 19 pandemic, a Video Conference via Google Meet was organized with the Directors of VAMNICOM/RICMs/ICMs & NCCT officials on 28th April, 2020 with the main objective to strategize the training & education programmes during lockdown and post Covid period. Shri Mohan Kumar Mishra, Secretary, NCCT welcomed the participants and advised them to stay safe in this critical situation. He said that in the present scenario, all the activities of the units have been badly affected and hence there is a great need to chalk out a workable road map for conducting the short term and long term programmes in this adverse situation. He urged all the Directors to commutate the suggestions in this regard. Director, VAMNICOM suggested to form a Committee for organizing the online training programmes and also suggested that the faculty members should complete all the pending projects, case studies, articles etc. Secretary, NCCT suggested to form a Committee with technical people who can advise us about the methodology and guidelines for all the units Committee with technical people who can advise us about the methodology and guidelines for all the units till we develop the infrastructure. Then Directors of all the training units interacted with the Secretary, NCCT on various issues.
