OBSERVANCE OF VIGILANCE AWARENESS WEEK (31st October, 2022 to 6th November, 2022)





In compliance to the communication dated 28th September, 2022 issued by the Government of India regarding observance of Vigilance Awareness Week from 31st October, 2022 to 6th November, 2022 on the theme "Corruption free India for a Developed Nation", the NCCT and all its training Institutes observed the Vigilance Awareness Week during the above period.

The Central Vigilance Commission (CVC) kick started the Vigilance Awareness Week by organizing an event at Vigyan Bhawan on 3rd November, 2022 which was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi. CVOs of various departments, Ministries and CVC officials attended the same. Shri Manish Bhatia, Administrative Officer, NCCT participated in the event on behalf of NCCT and its Institutes.

On 31.10.2022 at 11.00 AM all the officers and staff of NCCT (HQ) and all its training institutes including the participants of various training courses participated in the pledge taking ceremony and took the Integrity Pledge for Citizens. During the Integrity Pledge, Secretary, NCCT addressed the Officers and Staff and stressed on the chosen theme of the Vigilance Awareness Week "Corruption Free India for a Developed Nation" and reiterated that the purpose of the Vigilance Awareness Week is to generate awareness in the public at large about the ill effects of corruption.

On the occasion of the Vigilance Awareness Week a Workshop in Hybrid mode was organized by NCCT (HQ) on 04.11.2022 from 11.00 AM onwards in which officers and Staff Members from all the Institutes of NCCT participated. The theme of the workshop was "Corruption free India for a Developed Nation". On this occasion Sh. Sandeep Kumar Singh, Deputy Secretary, Ministry of Cooperation and Sh. P.N. Shukla, Director, Vigilance (Retd.) were invited as resource persons. Speaking on the occasion Shri Sandeep Singh stressed that necessary orientation on vigilance matters and rules and regulations should be given to all the new joinees and the probationers as this will instill a sense of seriousness in them which will go a long way in their personal growth. He suggested that the NCCT (HQ) should compile the guidelines pertaining to CVC and preventive vigilance and disseminate the same to each and every staff/officers of NCCT and its Institutes so as to create a general sense of awareness in them to carry out their day to day activity.

Sh. P.N. Shukla, Director, Vigilance (Retd.) also kept his views on this occasion and informed that Central Vigilance Commission started observing the Vigilance Awareness Week from the year 2000 under the able leadership of Sh. V.N. Vittal, former Chief Vigilance Commissioner with an objective to curb corruption. He informed that the Government has taken various steps in legal field, like Prevention of Corruption Act, RTI, Lokpal and also in the administrative matters like CPGRAM, e-

Governance and GeM portal etc. He also informed that there is a CVC guideline containing checklists that will help us to do the activities in well coordinated manner and promote preventive vigilance over punitive vigilance.
