Achievements - 2022-23

National Council for Cooperative Training (NCCT) is a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 promoted by Ministry of Cooperation, Government of India. NCCT's highest body is the Governing Council with Hon'ble Union Minister for Cooperation as its President. NCCT is responsible for organizing, directing, monitoring and evaluating the arrangements for cooperative training for the personnel working in the cooperative sector in the country as well as other stakeholders of Cooperative Sector. These activities of National Council for Cooperative Training are conducted through 20 Institutes at National Level, Regional Level and State Level located all over the country. All the RICMs and ICMs are accredited with C-PEC, BIRD, Lucknow.






HIGHEST EVER ACHIEVEMENT

The year 2022-23 has been a watershed year for the NCCT as it has recorded highest ever achievement on all fronts – be it in terms of number of training and awareness programmes conducted, or number of participants trained, or number of workshops/webinars/seminars organized, or use of social media for spreading the awareness among masses about the Government of India's schemes, programmes and new initiatives. During the year 2022-2023, major achievements of NCCT were as under:

- i) A total of **3287** training programmes covering **201507** participants have been conducted against the target of 1740 programmes and 43500 participants;
- ii) A total of **565** high level webinars/seminars/workshops were organized;
- iii) Record amount of internal resource generation of **Rs.17.54 crore** (preaudited);
- iv) Tentative expenditure of **Rs.51.21 crore** during the year









RANGE OF TRAINING PROGRAMMES

The NCCT has designed its programmes in such a way that they suit the requirements of all types of cooperatives and cooperative personnel in the country. Thus, NCCT conducts:

- i) Long Term Post Graduate Programmes, like Post Graduate Diploma in Management-Agri Business Management (PGDM-ABM), MBA, BBA etc.
- ii) Long Term Diploma Programmes, like Post Graduate Diploma in Cooperative Business Management, Higher Diploma in Cooperative Management (HDCM), sectoral diploma etc.
- iii) Short Term Programmes in Credit (PACS, UCBs) and Non Credit Sector (Dairy, Fishery, Handloom, Marketing, Processing etc.). In addition, programmes for Armed Personnel from Directorate General of Resettlement (DGR) are also organized as per requirement.
- iv) Three to five days programmes, under Warehousing Development and Regulatory Authority (WDRA) and NABARD-SOFTCOB organised for PACS.
- v) Out of the total participants trained by NCCT, **77209 women** participants were trained.
- vi) Summary of total Participants **201507 (General 102385, SC 25862, ST 20621, OBC 52639)**
- vii) Capacity Building of NCCT Employees:
 - Faculty Development Programme (Writing Management Case Studies covering 12 Faculty Members, Capacity Building on Community Base Organization at BIRD, Managlore covering 5 Faculty Members, All India Conference of Principals/Directors of Cooperative Training Institutes by BIRD at Munnar covering 6 Faculty Members)
 - Two training programmes for employees of NCCT were organized one on "GST, TDS, PFMS Compliance and MIS Report of NCCT" covering 39 office superintendents and accountants and second on "Leveraging Technology for Modernization of Library Information System and Content Management" covering 22 Librarians of NCCT Institutes;

HIGH LEVEL NATIONAL WEBINARS/SEMINARS

During the year 2022-23, seven high level webinars/seminars were organized by NCCT. New Delhi as under:

I. On the occasion of 75th Year of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, NCCT organized a Webinar on "Rejuvenation of Primary Agricultural Cooperative Societies – Emerging Issues, Challenges and Way Ahead" on 29th April, 2022. The webinar was attended by a record number of 8113 participants.







- II. On the occasion of International Cooperative Day, NCCT organized a Webinar on "Convergence and Scaling Up in Cooperative Training" on 2nd July, 2022. The theme of the International Cooperative Day for the year 2022 was "Cooperatives Build a Better World". The webinar was attended by a record 988 number of participants.
- III. A one day **National Conference on Cooperative Development** was organised by the NCCT on 12th January, 2023 at LINAC, Gurugram. Shri Gyanesh Kumar, IAS, Secretary, Ministry of Cooperation, Government of India inaugurated the National Conference as Chief Guest. Altogether 92 delegates participated in the conference.
- IV. To bring wider awareness about the new businesses identified in the Model Bye-Laws, NCCT organized a Webinar on "Emerging New Business Opportunities through Model Bye-Laws for PACS" on 30th January, 2023. Eight dignitaries, eminent in their respective fields, addressed the participants. A total of 2893 participants joined the webinar from all over the country.
- V. Immediately after announcement of Union Budget for 2023-24, the NCCT organized a webinar on (i) "Relief to Sugar Cooperatives"; and (ii) "Impact of Income Tax Proposals" on 7th February, 2023, key note address was delivered by Shri Satish Marathe, Director, Central Board, RBI. A total of 839 participants joined the webinar from all over the country.
- VI. To celebrate the International Women's Day, the NCCT organized a webinar on "Innovation and Technological Change for Gender Equality and Empowerment of Women in Cooperatives" on 7th March, 2023. A total of **751 participants** joined the webinar.
- VII. In view of the importance of cyber security and the threats hackers pose, the NCCT organized a webinar on "Cyber Security Preparedness for Cooperative Sector" on 24th March, 2023. A total of 1267 participants joined the webinar.

PUBLICITY AND OUTREACH

Target Audience: Grassroots Level Cooperative Members, BoDs & Staff

- NCCT played a big role in dissemination of information about the initiatives taken by Ministry of Cooperation through utilization of various social media.
- News articles were written on Model Bye-Laws for PACS, Computerization of PACS, Multi-State Cooperative Societies on Seed, Organic and Export and also on Income Tax Provisions for Cooperative Sector under Union Budget 2023-24. All the articles were got translated in 12 Regional Languages and a total of 207 articles were published on the 6 initiatives taken by Government as mentioned above. Altogether for the above mentioned Government's schemes and initiatives, total reach among public has been a whopping 6.19 crore.































Expenditure and Net Internal Resource Generation during the last 3 years
