Inauguration of Outreach and Dissemination Workshop on new Initiatives/ Schemes and Achievements for the Cooperative Sector by Sh. Gyanesh Kumar, IAS, Secretary, Ministry of Cooperation on 7th June, 2023.

A one day "Outreach and Dissemination Workshop on new Initiatives/Schemes and Achievements for the Cooperative Sector" was organized by NCCT on 7th June, 2023 on behalf of the Ministry of Cooperation, Government of India. The workshop aimed to bring attention to the remarkable achievements and initiatives taken by Ministry of Cooperation and create awareness among various stakeholders, including journalists, media persons, social media campaigners, writers, and authors in the field of cooperation. The workshop was inaugurated by Sh. Gyanesh Kumar, IAS, Secretary, Ministry of Cooperation, Government of India.

In his inaugural address, Shri Gyanesh Kumar emphasized on the importance of cooperatives in India. He mentioned that Indian cooperatives have a membership of around 30 crore, which would make it the 4th largest populated country in the world. He highlighted that the 41 new initiatives and various schemes have been approved by the Cabinet and implemented by the Ministry of Cooperation in a short span of time. He called upon the media persons to use their writing power to create awareness among the cooperatives at the grassroots level and encouraged them to showcase the collective efforts in spreading the message of cooperation. Shri Gyanesh Kumar expressed his deepest appreciation and gratitude to the media persons for their participation in the Workshop. He expressed the hope to look forward to future collaborations and continued engagement with the media persons to promote cooperation and empower cooperative members. He said that another follow up workshop will be organised in September, 2023, focusing on the progress and impact achieved since the previous event. As a part of this upcoming workshop, he requested the participants to attend the workshop and bring a compendium of published articles to showcase the collective efforts in spreading the message of Ministry of Cooperation.

Various sessions were organized by the resource persons who explained the initiatives of the Ministry, including the establishment of new multi-purpose PACS (Primary Agricultural Credit Societies) over a period of five years. They discussed the convergence of various government schemes through cooperatives and highlighted the training sessions conducted for PACS at the grassroots level.










SENSITIZATION WORKSHOP ON RELEVANCE OF SOCIAL MEDIA FOR THE NODAL OFFICERS OF NCCT AND TRAINING UNITS





Inauguration of Sensitization Workshop on relevance of Social Media for the Nodal Officers of NCCT and its Training Units by Sh. Kapil Meena, Deputy Secretary, Ministry of Cooperation on 8th June, 2023.

"Sensitization Workshop on importance and relevance of Social Media" was organized by NCCT at New Delhi on 8th June, 2023 for its Nodal Officers handling social media activities of the NCCT Headquarters and its Training Units viz VAMNICOM/RICMs/ICMs. The main objective of the workshop was to sensitize the participants about the need and relevance of Social Media and various social media platforms available which can be used to canvas the training activities of NCCT and dissemination of information related to the achievements of cooperative sector to the masses. The workshop was inaugurated by Shri Kapil Meena, Deputy Secretary, Ministry of Cooperation through Hybrid Mode. Shri Meena highlighted the importance of social media in today's digital age and emphasized its potential for cooperative training institutions. He

encouraged the participants to leverage social media platforms to enhance engagement, disseminate information, and foster collaboration in the cooperative sector.

Various sessions were organized by the resource persons who introduced the participants to social media, how to use social media to connect with customers, how to use social media to promote product and services as well as to promote the best practices of the social media.

The workshop concluded with a valedictory address by Shri Chandrasekhar Buddha, Chief Communication Officer, National Educational Alliance for Technology (NEAT), AICTE, New Delhi. Shri Buddha expressed his appreciation for the workshop and highlighted the significance of social media in the training and cooperative sectors.

The main recommendations of the Workshop were:

- 1. To achieve the target of reaching 1 crore by the end of the year 2023-24.
- 2. To like, share and follow the website, posts, tweets of each Institution/individual.
- 3. To like share and follow the Posts of the Ministry of Cooperation.
- 4. Conducting one Review meeting through VC of all the Directors and Nodal Officers of NCCT and its Training Units.
- 5. Institutions must identify the target audience; align goal and objectives with social media expansion strategy.
- 6. Develop valuable content that educates, informs and add value to the target audience.
- 7. Create a content calendar to ensure consistent posting.
- 8. Include the mix of text, images, videos and other multimedia formats. Encourage user engagement and interaction by promptly responding to comments, messages and inquiries from followers.
- 9. Leverage influencers and subject/industry experts to amplify reach and credibility.
- 10. Use social media analytics tools to track performance and gather insights.
- 11. Highlight the potential benefits of an effective social media presence for the NCCT's growth and success.


